We have now been using Patchs since May 2023. All requests should be put in through Patchs to be triaged by our duty doctor. If you are unable to use Patchs please contact our reception team who will be happy to help you with your request. The portal opens at 7:30am and closes at 4:30pm. Patchs Telephone Assistant is coming in the New Year to improve access for patients that cannot use online services and to eliminate call waiting times. This is a new way to access the surgery. Patients speak to the Telephone Assistant who takes the details of their request. The message is automatically transcribed and is sent to the Patchs inbox for the GP to review like a standard Patchs online consultation.
